

# Clerk's report

## Mattishall Parish Council

June 2024

1. No further update regarding the broken and faded street names on Church Plain and Welgate.
2. The Scout Hut have accepted the portrait of the King with thanks.
3. Mr Linton, the placement coordinator from the Probation Services Community Payback team has advised that although the proposed work we put forward is suitable they do have stipulations regarding a suitable length which normally needs to a minimum of 6 weeks. He had advised that if we have any other projects in mind, we could bundle them up to hopefully meet the 6 week timeframe. Any suggestions please?
4. The standpipe installation was successfully carried out on Saturday 11 May.
5. The rubber mulch installation to the Play Area is provisionally booked in for 3 June, weather permitting. The Barlow Charity have been notified and has agreed to inform residents nearer the time. Communications will go out to residents a few days before once the weather forecast has been assessed. The substation to the play area (near Dereham Road) will be coned off the night before so that NGF Play have an allocated area for materials.
6. A date has been scheduled to install the Village Map to the Church Rooms car park wall on 29 May at 6:30pm. All Councillors are invited to attend.
7. A resident has asked if the Council would consider additional dog bins at the following locations: 1) Corner of Old Hall Road, 2) Heath Road, Welborne Common Junction, 3) Mattishall Lane, Clippings Green Junction. Please note any new locations will require permission from Breckland District Council and landowner (see map locations attached).
8. Mr Ray Taylor would like to thank the Parish Council ahead of the installation for the additional names to be added to the War Memorial for Private Wrighton and Private Frost, his full email can be read in the shared folder.

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9. I was asked to obtain permission from the Swan Pub to arrange for a Skip hire to be located for a day at the car park near the lock up. I am pleased to confirm that we have received permission from the Landlord and Landlady but have been asked to arrange for delivery to be made on a Monday and collected by 3pm on the Tuesday to limit disruption. Please can those who will be attending confirm a date so that I can arrange this.
  
10. Some residents have raised concerns regarding the safety on South Green from large fallen tree branches outside Mattishall Hall, South Green, please see pictures attached. I have reported to Highways to investigate - ENQ900268049.
