

A47 North Tuddenham to Easton

Full weekend road closure

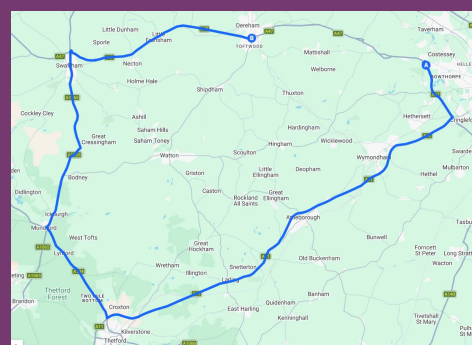
The A47 will be fully closed in both directions from Longwater Interchange to Dereham Interchange between 8pm Friday 29 May and 6am Monday 1 June 2026. Please note that there will be no access from side roads onto this section of the A47 from 7:30pm on Friday 29 May.

We'll be constructing the new Lyng Road junction and connecting it to a new local access road and the current A47. We'll also be carrying out preparation work on the new route to Mattishall Lane, and junction and construction work linked to removing the Easton roundabout.

Note: During our road closure there will also be an abnormal load moving from Kings Lynn to Necton from 9am to 1pm on Sunday 31 May. This will use part of our diversion route between Swaffham and Necton. Please allow extra time for your journey.

Westbound Diversion Route:

- Head east on the A47
- Join the A11 and head southwest
- Leave A11 at Thetford and join the A134 heading northwest
- At Mundford take the A1065 north towards Swaffham
- Rejoin the A47 at Swaffham and head east.
- Eastbound traffic should follow this route in reverse.



All side road access will be closed onto the A47. Residents living directly on the A47 will be escorted through the closure by traffic marshals when access is required during the closure. Access routes through the closure will be maintained for the Emergency Services.

Following this closure, a new road layout will be in place at the junction of Lyng Road and the A47.



- A47 will close from 8pm on Friday 29 May 2026 to connect new Lyng Road Junction to Local Access Road and current A47
- New stretch of a Local Access Road will open from 6am on Monday 1 June
- Traffic will switch onto new Lyng Road & Local Access Road alignments to flow east to west

After the full road closure we will be switching traffic onto our new Lyng Road layout and local access roads. Please take extra care driving through the new road layout.
